CUT STRING STAIRS EXPLAINED

THE MULTI-TURN CUT STRING

A GRANDER STAIR DESIGN, MADE THE TRADITIONAL WAY

RETURN ENDS TO TREADS

These are to hide the end grain on the treads, this enhances the look of quality which belongs to a cut string staircase



RISERS MITRED INTO STRING

These are to hide the end grain on the risers (with decorative brackets the riser is mitred into the bracket)



SPINDLES TENONED INTO TREADS

For ease of fitting on site the spindles are simply located into pockets on treads

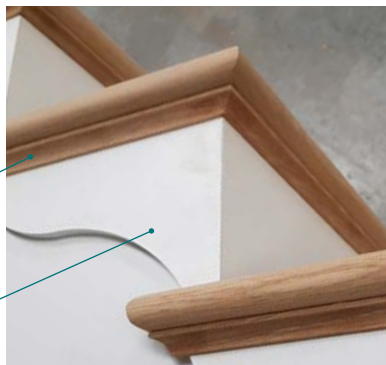


OPTIONAL EXTRAS

BUDGET OPTIONS

When a cut string staircase is painted, MDF treads can be used as a more cost effective option. As MDF has no grain, the return nosing is integral
